## Creating an Experience for Healing

Patient rooms in the new hospital will be bathed in abundant, natural light. This unique, calming setting for care has been proven to have a positive impact on patient healing.

### INTEGRATED SPACES

The building will be linked to research buildings, allowing investigators to translate their lab work to clinical trials that may help patients heal more quickly.

Every patient floor will include spaces to support healthcare education, enabling teams to interact in patient care.

The expansion is a concrete example of Ohio State's expansion in the area of life sciences. This new space will bring together areas of study and research that may not have collaborated before to find ways to prevent, treat and cure disease.

### CRITICAL CARE PATIENT ROOMS

New operating rooms and Intensive Care Unit patient rooms will be located in the critical care spaces.

To facilitate family support in the healing process, every critical care patient room will have adjoining comfort zones where loved ones can stay, sleep and shower.

### CANCER PATIENT ROOMS

Fully equipped rooms in the new James Cancer Hospital and Solove Research Institute will allow patients to receive nearly all of their treatment in the comfort of their own room, rather than visiting multiple locations.

### GREEN SPACES

There will be beautiful green spaces for patients, visitors and staff to meet, rest and reflect in the Phyllis G. Jones Legacy Park located in front of the new hospital and the Chlois G. Ingram Spirit of Women Park located south of the Rhodes Hall loop.

Additional rooftop terraces on the new building will allow patients and their families to view and visit green spaces during their stay.

### PUBLIC AREAS

A patient-friendly concourse and inviting lobby will link laboratories, classrooms, administrative offices and garages, offering patients and family members convenient access to healthcare services across the Medical Center.

Included is a expanded Emergency Department with a new public and ambulance entrance.

### SUSTAINABLE DESIGN

Certified under the Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) Green Building Rating System™ for its use of sustainable and eco-friendly material, technologies and building practices, the new building will use 20 percent less energy than standard building.

## EXPANSION BY THE NUMBERS
